Dear Parent/Carer

As we approach the end of term I want to thank you for your continued support of the school.

Firstly a reminder that the school will close on Thursday 2nd April at 14:30. For those young people travelling by school transport bus companies have been notified. Staff and students will return to school at 8.45 am on Monday 20th April. I would appreciate your support in ensuring that all students wear school uniform and arrive punctually.

On Wednesday 22nd April we will be launching our new version of the school website. We are hosting a twilight 'drop-in' from 16:00 – 18:00 in the school library for anyone who wishes to join us. We will continue to work in partnership with you to ensure every individual maximises their potential and strives to gain the awards they deserve.

For our students currently in S1/2/3 their new timetable for 2015/16 will commence on Monday 11th May. Students returning for the new S5/6 will begin on Monday 1st June. These changes allow our young people to embark on new courses and maintain a focussed approach to their learning.
