Prelim Assessment Rules

Prelim assessments will be held mainly in the Museum though sometimes the Assembly Hall too along with other specific rooms.

On arrival...

- you must sit in the seat allocated on the seating plan and/or by the teacher/invigilator
- wait for instructions from the invigilator and/or teacher before starting the assessment or exam
- bags are not allowed in the exam hall or room but you can bring an outdoor jacket which you should place over the back of your seat during the exam/assessment
- note the items below that are not permitted in the assessment or exam room



Mobile phones



Electronic devices such as iPods, tablets, smartwatches or any other device that stores information or can connect to the internet



Extra information – books, notes, sketches or paper, and anything written on your clothes or body



Pencil cases or calculator cases



Calculators, except for exam papers where calculators are allowed



Dictionaries, except for exam papers where dictionaries are allowed

If you are not able to sit an assessment or prelim exam, for example if you are unwell that day, you will be able to sit at another time which you can arrange with your teachers.
