#### **Welcome to the fourth monthly installment of the Kier Community newsletter.**

The final phase of works are drawing to a close and what was once a hectic building site now appears as its intended use, two all-weather sporting pitches.

In terms of progress over the last four weeks, we have completed the floodlight installation; twelve masts have been designed and erected in a way that the bright light efficiently covers each entire pitch with no light spillage or pollution to any surrounding area.

The synthetic carpet is finished on the rugby / football field and the hockey field, with all the line markings included. Adjacent to these fields are three sets of 7 a-side goal posts, two sets of full pitch football goalposts, one set of rugby posts, and three sets of hockey goals along with two dug-out shelters for each pitch.

Most noticeably for neighbours we have completed the access road works and Kier would like to thank all residents for their patience and co-operation during the last week. The road has been resurfaced and widened to allow two lanes of traffic, with a number of potholes also remedied.

**Upcoming works** include finishing the monoblock footpaths and testing the floodlights along with uplifting the site welfare units and reinstating all damaged grass areas around the site compound.

Next month we will give you another update on progress and let you know if there are any items of our works that may affect you. As always, please feel free to contact us if you have any concerns.

### Who can I contact to discuss any concerns or complaints that I may have?

Concerns or complaints from neighbours or adjoining properties can be dealt with by contacting the site manager based in the project office located in the contractors compound Tel No. **07580 542283** between **8am & 4.30pm mon to fri.**

### How can you help us?

Construction sites are potentially dangerous places to enter especially for non-site personnel. Those who work on the new Marr Pitches site will be required to complete a site induction process. This will explain in detail the potential risks and how they can keep themselves safe at all times. Site personnel are also required to wear special clothing and footwear called Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to assist in maintaining their safety. Anyone entering the site without PPE or the benefit of the site induction is potentially in great danger. We would ask you to remind your children that they should never attempt to enter the building site. When the site is closed, we would also ask neighbours to report to the police anyone you see on the site that they consider should not be there. Your help and co-operation in this matter is appreciated.
