6. Labour Market Presentation

Labour market presentation from skills development Scotland that reports on final destinations for students and can then identify where the gaps are in education.

In SA for every 100 people of working age there are 69 of non-working age – it is predicted to increase.

The Ayrshire growth deal is trying to skill young people to allow them to continue to live in SA. Key areas in Ayrshire– Hospitality and Tourism, Space and Aerospace. Health and Social care, and Agriculture

Developing curriculum to support this for example Food and Health Technology at Higher level 3 x HE teachers. Event Management courses also being run, pupils ran Secret Santa for staff – 3rd years achieved a level 4 qualification. Some negative perceptions with hospitality and tourism long hours low pay

Engineering and Aerospace Magnata are planning to build satellites within SA- teaching for careers that are not yet developed. Growth deal fund worth around £250million

As a school we need support to put relevant courses in place that employers are looking for, for example Design Engineer Construct and PEO Courses

BP noted a shortage of many jobs like environmental health officers, quantity surveyors.

Shortage of school equipment for practical experience but college able to provide this.
Foundation apprenticeships can be run in school.

Struggling to recruit and retain in HSCP due to lack of perceived progression and aging population in SA. Shortage of trades for construction. South Ayrshire is a popular retirement destination.
