After a month of dreadful weather, it's great to confirm that the wind, rain and snow hasn't stopped the Marr College Project from keeping to the programme.

The concrete frame to the rear of the existing Historic Building is nearly complete up to and including the new school entrance. On the roof of the Historic Building, slating and lead work is now progressing well.



ABOUT THE PROJECT:

Hub South West Scotland is delivering the Marr College project on behalf of South Ayrshire Council. Hub South West have appointed Kier Construction as the Construction Delivery Partner for Marr College. Designed by BDP Architects this build will increase the school's capacity to 1,360 pupils in time for the August term in 2017. A single-storey sports facility will also be built which will benefit not only the school but the local community too as it will be accessible to the wider community out with school hours.

CONSIDERATE CONSTRUCTORS SCHEME

The primary aim of the Considerate Constructors Scheme (CCS) is to improve the image of construction by encouraging the highest standards of conduct across the industry.

Participating sites must sign up to the CCS Code of Considerate Practice. Projects are scored according to how well they perform in each of the eight section of the code: Considerate, Environment, Appearance, Good Neighbour, Respectful, Safety, Responsible and Accountable.
