



Marr All Weather Facilities

Welcome to the first monthly installment of the Kier Community newsletter.

Works are continuing this week with the arrival of our specialist sub-contractor, WH Malcolm. This phase will be the 'cut and fill', which essentially means the leveling and redistribution of soil. Earth will be moved using heavy mobile machinery including excavators, dumper trucks and bulldozers. A traffic management plan has been produced to ensure that there is minimal disruption to any adjacent areas (see other side).

On Thursday 20th February an official turf cutting ceremony took place. The gathering was attended by representatives from Kier, South Ayrshire Council, SW Hub and pupils from Marr College. Photographs to follow in next month's newsletter.

Who can I contact to discuss any concerns or complaints that I may have?

How can you help us?

Construction sites are potentially dangerous places to enter especially for non-site personnel. Those who work on the new Marr Pitches site will be required to complete a site induction process. This will explain in detail the potential risks and how they can keep themselves safe at all times. Site personnel are also required to wear special clothing and footwear called Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to assist in maintaining their safety. Anyone entering the site without PPE or the benefit of the site induction is potentially in great danger. We would ask you to remind your children that they should never attempt to enter the building site. When the site is closed, we would also ask neighbours to report to the police anyone you see on the site that they consider should not be there. Your help and co-operation in this matter is appreciated.
