On the 21st October 2018, a team of education staff from South Ayrshire Council visited Marr College. During our visit we talked to young people and worked closely with the head teacher and staff. We gathered evidence to evaluate aspects of the learning provision.

The team found the following strengths in the school:

- The leadership of the head teacher and depute head teachers in successfully improving the culture for learning.
- The range of out-of-class activities which are planned for young people which are enabling them to develop important skills for life.
- The positive relationships across the school which are contributing to a constructive learning environment.

The areas for improvement outlined below were identified and discussed with the head teacher and depute head teachers. We agreed the school needs to:

- Develop further opportunities for staff to share good practice within the school and beyond. This will support the development of consistency in high-quality learning and teaching.
- Continue to develop opportunities for young people to lead their learning in lessons. This will encourage them to take more responsibility for their learning and will help raise attainment.
