Dear Parent/Carer

I hope that you and your family continue to be safe and well. I am writing to update you on important information regarding the planned phased return following the February break, the voluntary asymptomatic testing programme for schools and a reminder of our upcoming Careers and Options evenings.

Phased Return

Earlier this week the First Minister set out arrangements for a part-time phased return to in-school learning for a very limited number of students in S4-6 to complete practical work that is essential for completing national qualifications. All other students, with the exception of those already accessing childcare provision, will continue with remote learning. It is intended that there will be no more than 5 - 8% of a secondary school roll physically present at any one time for these purposes. For Marr College, this equates to between 50 – 80 students senior students attending per day. Two metre physical distancing for adults and students will be required in school.

Alongside this limited phased return, staff and S4-S6 students attending in school will be offered at-home testing two times a week. It is anticipated that this will commence from Monday 22nd February and specific details will be issued to you next week.

Work has already begun on identifying priority subjects and creating practical groupings to ensure 2m distancing can be observed in class. We will be in touch with parents and carers next week to confirm arrangements for practical subjects.

These decisions will be confirmed by the Scottish Government on Tuesday 16 February - providing sufficient progress in tackling the virus has been made.
